Statement of Purpose

The purpose for the RCDCU Bike-A-Thon is to raise money to increase the awareness of Prostate Cancer and the importance of early detection. Contributions will be made to the Robert Wood Johnson Hospital Foundation that will be providing three days of FREE prostate cancer screening to the cyclist and men throughout the communities of Somerset and Middlesex counties. According to statistics released from the Prostate Cancer Foundation, nearly 218,000 men were diagnosed with prostate cancer last year and more than 32,000 died. It is estimated that more than 2 million American men are currently living with prostate cancer. As men increase in age, their risk of developing prostate cancer increases exponentially. African American men are 60% more likely to develop prostate cancer compared to Caucasian men and nearly 2.5 times likely to die from the disease.

THE BIKE ROUTES

The Bike-A-Thon begins and ends at Renaissance Community Development Credit Union at 55 Fuller Street. Somerset, NJ
